

Summer Session 2010 - Information

We experienced Shawnigan Lake School last summer and are very pleased with what they have to offer. We will be able to stay together on campus for classes, accommodation and meals in a beautiful environment.

Classrooms – will be in one building assigned to us.

Accommodation – will be in one residence assigned to us. Most rooms have bunk beds, with 2 desks (no lamp provided – bring your own if possible). There are 4 rooms with two bunks which can accommodate a family of 4, with desks but, again, no lamps. Bathrooms are shared. Cost will be \$26.25 per person per night. The cost will be the same for weekend nights, which must be paid for if you will be continuing into the next week.

Meals – will be provided in the dining room. Some special diets can be accommodated; vegetarian, gluten free and lactose free. There will be an opportunity for those with dietary needs to meet with the kitchen staff. If you have other special dietary needs, a tiny kitchen and regular size fridge are available in the residence. **This will be reserved for the use of those with special diets only.**

The cost of the meals are: breakfast (\$9.50) which includes morning and afternoon snacks, lunch (\$12.50) and dinner (\$14.25). All meals are buffet style with a very wide variety.

If meals are not needed at weekends, there will be no charge. Only register for meals you intend to take.

Children are welcome on campus; for those under 10, the meals and accommodation will be half price. We are currently exploring options for childcare off site.

Phone access and internet access with a laptop will be available.
